Services (RDS) Other Issues and Opportunities ■ CF Features to Aid Remote Dev ■ Wishlist for new features Vocabulary ■ What do we mean by "Remote Development"? - Workstation development with remote hosting - Remote Development Services in 3.1/Studio – Not really referring to: • Accessing a database not on the CF server • Remote admin of CF server Challenges of Remote Dev. ■ Deploying code remotely ■ Addressed in new Studio features ■ But much more to it: - CF Admin controls many features, but not generally accessible to users on remote - Server logs in restricted directories - Custom tags: identifying, installing - Debugging challenges - Many global features may not be good for all

## Risks in Remote Hosting ■ Anyone given CF Admin pw has total access - obvious, but worth being wary of ■ Some CF tags can access all files, .i.e. yours ■ CF Server logs are for all users ■ New Studio RDS services controlled by one password for entire server Others can cause ill effects on your app Controlling/Manipulating Remote Datasources Datasources are usually locked by server ■ Challenges ability to up/download database ■ Solutions: - Admin. can redefine datasource to not "maintain database connections" - Generate a SQL error to unlock - Use SQL DDL and DML - Create dummy datasources New Remote Dev Features of 3.1 ■ Called RDS, enabled primarily by Studio - Direct file edit on, ftp to/from server - Visual database tools can guery, display data and show database structure ■ Requires that server be updated to 3.1 (which is a special one-time free upgrade) - Requires knowledge of server "Studio" pw

Potential problems using Studio/RDSUsing features when password not enabled

## Other Issues/Opportunities ■ Use single-user CF Server for local testing Debugging alternatives ■ Verity Collections: without Admin access ■ Scheduling: without Admin access ■ Encryption: protect your code ■ Backing up remote databases ■ Project Upload Wizard Other Issues/Opportunities (cont) ■ Determining remote server's CF version ■ CF Server's many logs ■ Determining "actual" path names ■ Creating temporary files ■ Accessing database on non-CF server ■ Remotely controlling the CF server wkstn ■ Using Custom Tags--even when you "can't" CF features to Aid Remote Dev ■ CFERROR - valuable, but tricky ■ CFQUERY - can override db userid/pw ■ Debugging - can set for ip, page, query ■ CFSCHEDULE - can do all scheduling ■ CFINDEX - can do nearly all indexing ■ CFCRYPT - can protect templates

# CF Remote Dev Wishlist ■ Version 4 to address many remote dev problems. Some I'd suggest: - more than one RDS/Studio password - user-level control of defined datasource - finer control of 4 "restricted" tags - resolve CFMAIL mimeattach hole CF Remote Dev Wishlist (cont) - finer, app-level control of server settings - option to segregate logs by application - enable debugging by application - enable listing of installed custom tags **Summary** ■ Have identified several problems and solutions ■ Many have been surprised to learn what's possible ■ Or what's difficult for others which they take for granted ■ Can be applied to increase your productivity ■ and...
